7 DAY CAMPS

Thank you for your interest in our Horse Riding Camps. Kiah Park was established in 1978 and consists of 315 beautiful acres situated 20km east of Gympie and 160km north of Brisbane. Visitors can enjoy the peaceful farm surroundings with horses and other farm animals.

Our 7 Day Riding Camps are held every school holidays, from 11am Saturday to the 7am the following Saturday. Kiah Park Horse Riding Camp is fully catered, has full insurance, qualified Instructors and adult supervision. Ages of children attending camp are boys 6 – 12 yrs and girls 6 – 15yrs and all riding abilities are catered for. For the safety of our riders and health of our horses we have a safety weight restriction of 90kg.

BOOKINGS

The price for our 7 Day Camp is \$895.00 per child.

Family - One only: \$895.00 Two: \$885.00each Three: \$875.00each (to be eligible for this family discount, children must reside in the same house)

Plus bus fare, see fares below. Add \$20 boot hire if your child requires riding boots for the week.

Booking forms can be completed online at our website or fill in and return the attached form, please book early to avoid disappointment. Tentative bookings cannot be held indefinitely, please **confirm by returning your deposit and booking form one week after a verbal booking**. Deposits are only refunded under exceptional circumstances and all cancellations incur a \$50 administration fee. Full camp fees are due prior to camp.

TRANSPORT

We hire a bus and pick up from Brisbane and different points up the coast. See timetable for pick up and drop off points and times. Cost of the bus is \$30 each way from Brisbane, Burpengary and Caboolture. Cost is \$27 each way from Caloundra, Nambour and Cooroy.

The bus departs at the time specified on the timetable, it cannot wait therefore it is vitally important that parents are at least 15 minutes early for pick up and drop off.

Private transport camper's drop off time at Kiah Park is between **11:00am – 12 noon**. Pick up time is the following Saturday is **7.00am**.

ACCOMMODATION

Our cabins are located along the ridge overlooking beautiful scenery. There are separate boys and girls cabins with their own hot showers and toilets. All cabins have double bunks and mattresses. A leader sleeps with the children and assists in each cabin.

Children are required to care for their belongings and keep their cabins tidy. Let us know on your booking form if your child would like to share a cabin with a friend that is also attending camp.

SUPERVISION

We employ one leader for every six children booked in to camp; the leaders are female and hold their blue cards. Leaders sleep in the cabins with the children so there is 24 hour supervision. Owners live on site and are involved in running and supervising the camp.

BEHAVIOUR

Children with behavioural problems are a risk to other campers and parents are required to ensure that their children understand and are able to respect the rights of others with regard to safety of persons and property, manners and privacy.

TUCKSHOP

The tuckshop is open in the morning and afternoon and sells drinks, chips, ice blocks and sweets. All wallets are locked away in the office for safe keeping.

PHONE CALLS

To minimise disruption to the camp routine, please keep calls to our landline to a minimum or emergencies. If you wish your child to bring a mobile phone, they will have an opportunity to call or text home at afternoon tea time. All phones are kept in safe keeping the rest of the day.

If you have to talk to your child call our landline 5486 6166 between 6.30 – 7.30pm. Calls after 7.30pm are not taken as the night activity has started and no-one is available to answer the phone.

Rest assured that we will contact you if there are any problems.

DINING

We have a large dining area where all campers meet for meals. Please let us know if your child has any special dietary needs as we will happily cater for them. There is a surcharge of \$50 for vegetarian and gluten free diets.

CAMP RULES

Our first priority is safety, closely followed by as much fun as possible. To ensure a happy and enjoyable camp for all we have established a set of rules to which we expect our campers to adhere. These will be explained to campers on day of arrival.

Campers are reminded that cigarettes, alcohol or other drugs are not permitted at our camp and any breakages must be paid for.

WHAT TO BRING

In order for your child to embrace the camp experience please do not bring any electronic devices such as ipads, kindles, ipods, electronic games (if brought along they will be locked in safe keeping for the week).

Children can bring a mobile phone to call/text home at afternoon tea time. All phones are kept in safe keeping the rest of the day.

To minimise disruption to the camp routine, please keep calls to our landline to a minimum or emergencies. We will call you if there are any problems.

* Bedding

- Single fitted sheet for mattress cover (compulsory even if using a sleeping bag, can be hired for \$8)
- Pillow and pillow case
- Doona or sleeping bag (flat sheet for hot nights in summer or extra blanket for chilly nights in winter)
- If necessary bring plastic mattress protector
- 2 garbage bags (for wet and dirty clothes)

* Towels

- 2 towels – one for showers and one for any water activities

* Toiletries

- Soap, shampoo, toothbrush, toothpaste, hair brush
- Deodorant roll on (no aerosols, we have found a lot of people are sensitive to these)
- Sunscreen
- Insect repellent (roll on type)

* Medication

- Must be noted on the booking form and handed in on arrival at camp
- Prescription medication to be in original packaging, prescribed to the child and indicating dosage

* Water Bottle

- Essential** – An over-the-shoulder water bottle or camelbak is suitable for riding. Over the shoulder water bottle holders are for sale at Kiah Park for \$10 (they fit a 600ml water bottle)

* Book

- A special book you are reading, please do not bring along electronic books

* Variety Show Item

- Thursday is Variety Show night. This is a fun night where you get a chance to share anything that we can all enjoy together eg A magic trick, musical instrument, song, joke or short skit

* Clothing (bring enough clothing for 7 days)

- Jeans or jodhpurs for riding (**long pants** are necessary for comfort and to prevent chaffing)
- Jumper
- Warm jacket for winter
- Tracksuit
- Socks & underwear (ensure socks are long enough to cover your ankles to avoid rubs from riding boots)
- Pyjamas
- Shorts
- T-shirts – (no crop tops, singlets or sleeveless tops for horse riding. Kiah Park polo shirts can be purchased for \$37 Navy or Royal blue)
- Swimming togs (we swim in the dam so bring along old togs and t-shirt to swim in)
- Raincoat (compulsory for rainy days, not the poncho style as they flap and frighten the horses. Rain jackets can be purchased at Kiah Park for \$25)
- Hat (compulsory for outdoor activities)

- * **Shoes** - 3 pairs – riding boots (used for riding only), thongs and closed in shoes (runners) for walks and playing
Smooth soled riding boots are compulsory for horse riding. Bring your own or hire boots \$20 per week

* Riding Helmet

- Bring your own or we will provide

* Wallet

- Bring spending money for the canteen; wallets will be locked in the canteen for safe-keeping

* Kiah Park Shop

- Kiah Park polo shirts & jumpers. Souvenirs for sale: thermo mugs, brush/mirror, rulers, bookmarks, pens, bracelets and toiletries

* Torch

* Tissues

- A small pack will do

* First Aid

- Band aids & panadol – please label with child's name

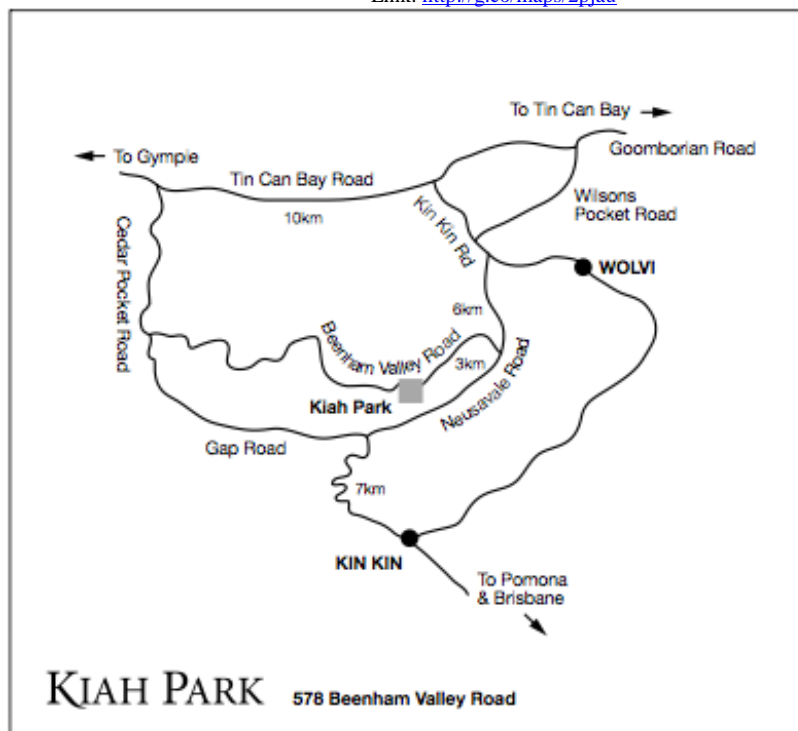

TRAVEL INSTRUCTIONS

The GPS systems seem to get people very lost please use directions below

(If travelling from Brisbane/Sunshine Coast this route is approx ½ hour shorter than going via Gympie)

1. From Brisbane/Sunshine Coast travel north on the Bruce Highway.
2. Take Exit 237 towards Pomona/Kin Kin, and follow signs at the roundabouts for Pomona.
3. Continue in direction of travel, then turn right at Pioneer Road (sign for Pomona/Kin Kin).
4. Turn right at T-junction onto Reserve Street.
5. Continue through Pomona Township, cross the railway line and turn left at Factory Street to Kin Kin.
6. Travel approx. 14km and turn left on Main Street to Kin Kin; pass the Kin Kin Pub and travel over the range to a T-junction – approx 7km
7. Turn right into Neusavale Rd – travel approx 6km
8. Turn left into Beenham Valley Rd – travel 3km
9. Turn left at **Kiah Park** - 578 Beenham Valley Road

OR

(This route is longer)

1. Take Highway 1 (Bruce Highway) to Gympie.
2. Turn right on Brisbane Road following directions to Tin Can Bay & Rainbow Beach
3. Turn right on Tin Can Bay Road – travel 10km
4. Turn right into Kin Kin Rd – travel approx 7km
5. Turn right into Neusavale Rd - travel approx 4km
6. Turn right into Beenham Valley Rd - travel 3km
7. Turn left at **Kiah Park** - 578 Beenham Valley Road
