BUSHRANGER FEATURES

CRUISEMASTER COIL SUSPENSION

Ask any experienced 'off-road caravanner' and they will tell you Cruisemaster Suspension is a must.

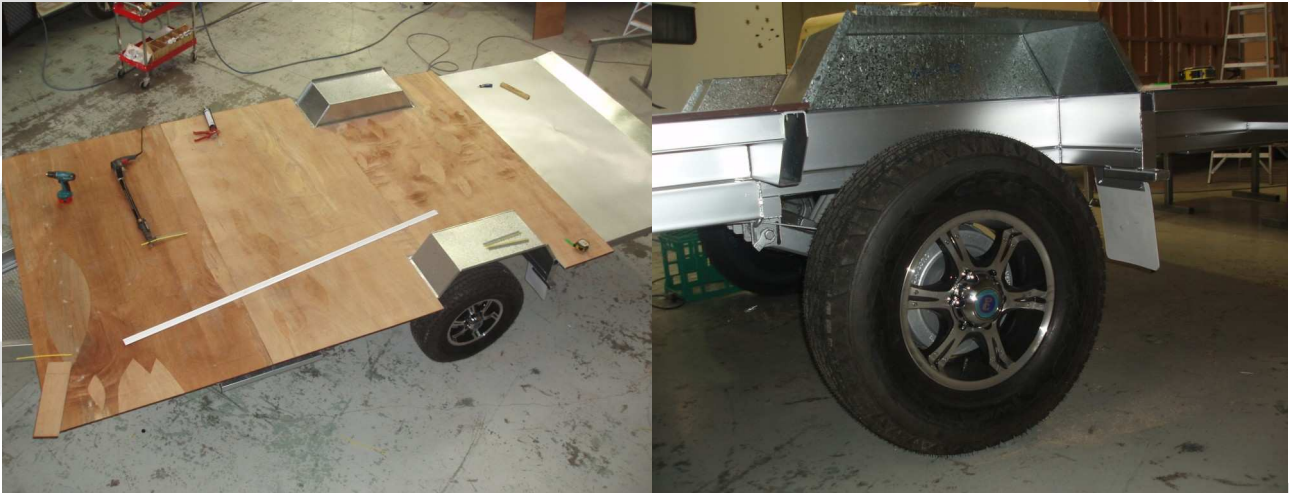
The Cruisemaster Coil suspension system is the modern day answer for economical load protection and towability. Softer spring rates help protect both the caravan and its contents.

The design incorporates a special twin rate spring system. Initially the coil provides the springing, then as the coil takes up the load a specially designed polyurethane spring guide comes into play. More than just a bump stop, this design registered feature provides a secondary higher spring rate for greater control at high loads.



A-FRAME & CHASSIS UPGRADE TO 6 INCHES, EXTENDED DRAW BAR AND GALVANISED SHEET REINFORCED FLOOR.

The A-frame, chassis and floor to your caravan are its foundations. So it only makes sense that if you are going to take it off-road that it needs to be strengthened. The increase in size of the A-frame and chassis are purely for strength and reinforcement purposes. The extended Draw bar is maneuverability and to avoid 'Jack knifing' and the reinforcement under the floor is to protect the inners of the Caravan from any road/track debris causing damage.



16" OFF-ROAD TYRES

Fitting 16" off-road tyres to your **BUSHRANGER** is going to give you that extra ride height and durability where required. An extra spare wheel is often desirable for piece of mind.

ENCLOSED JERRY CAN HOLDERS AND STEEL WATER TANK COVERS

Touring remote areas of Australia requires water. Water for drinking, water for washing, water for cooking. Here at Colorado Caravans we can fit your **BUSHRANGER** with enclosed Jerry Can holders and Steel water tank covers to protect your water supply from the elements and any road debris penetrating them.



RECESSED HYLAND HITCH

Built specifically for off-road use, the Hyland Hitch coupling allows for independent movement of the caravan from the towing vehicle (further to a standard coupling), crucial for tackling those rugged tracks.



HIGH CHECKER PLATE SIDES

Besides giving the caravan that rugged 'ready for anything' look, the high checker plate sides serve to protect the caravan from stone chips etc.



AGM BATTERIES

AGM batteries are designed with boating and off-road travel in mind. Each cell is completely sealed from the others which means that during 'rough' travels the acids from each cell do not mix.

SOLAR PANEL(S)

Available in 80, 130 or 150 watts. The addition of solar panels to a caravan eases the stress of trying to find powered sites, allowing freedom of travel.

...OTHER FEATURES...

Other features of note include the option of a Steel Pull-out step, for easy storage away. Mesh on the A-Frame for further protection from nasty road debris. A raised back (where possible) for protection of the rear underside of the van and much more.
