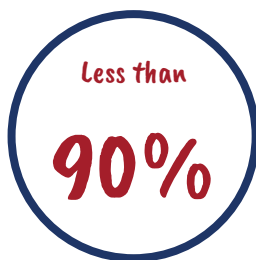

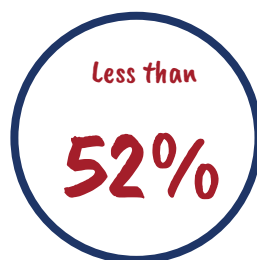

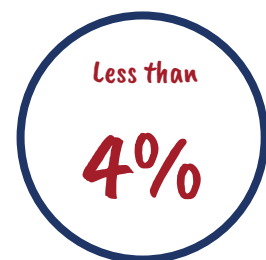
3.6 million children are born in Tanzania and Kenya each year. Of these children,

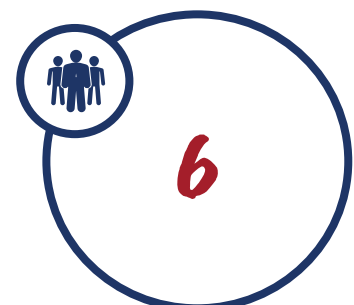
